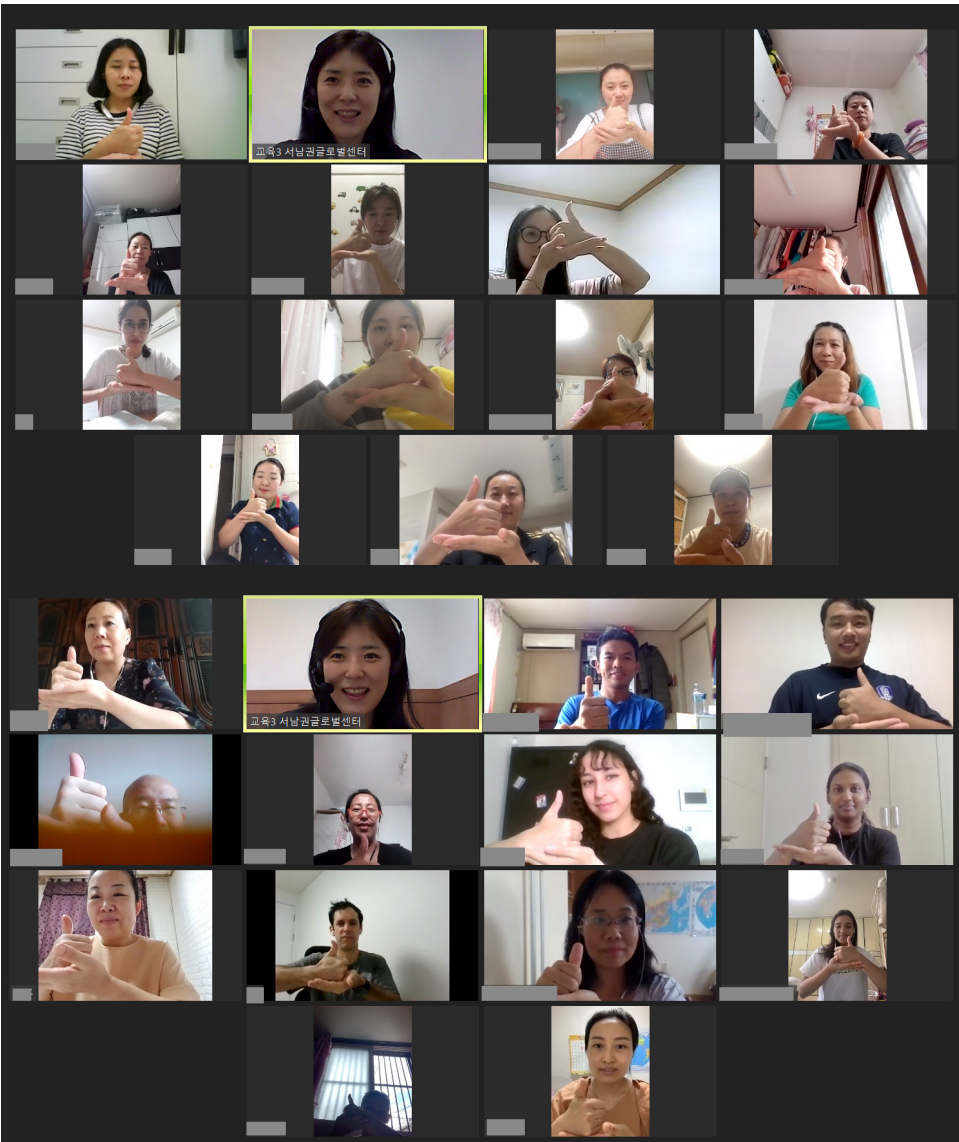

Foreign residents can be provided with emergency disaster relief as following!

Subject: From Aug. 31, 2020 (Monday) to Sep. 25, 2020 (Friday), registrations on-line or through a direct visit is required to foreigners who meet eligibility.

Amount: 300,000 won for a family of 1-2, 400, 000 won for a family of 3-4. 500,000 won for a family of 5 and more than 6

Payment System: After receiving a text message of information about deciding on payment, visit a neighborhood community center and receive a prepaid card. please.

Date and Place of Use

- Date of Use: until Dec. 15, 2020
- Place of Use : prepaid card affiliate stores such as marts, eating places, convenience stores and more in local regions (available only in Seoul. Not available in large marts and entertainment spots, available only off-line)

Programs on a Policy for Foreigners

Social Integration Program

- Subject: foreigners dwelling in Republic of Korea, who are to acquire the qualification of residence, such as nationality, permanent residency, foreigners acquiring nationality in less than three years
- Course
 - Korean Language and Korean Culture: 0-4 steps, placement of steps through pre-test (=level test)
 - An Understanding about Korean Society: 50 hours for acquiring permanent residency, 70 hours for acquiring nationality.
- Benefit of Earning Credits : exempted written or oral tests for nationalization



Early Adaptation Program

- Subject: foreign immigrants for the first time
 - Required Participation: ethnic Korean visiting Republic of Korea for the purpose of getting jobs, and hotels or entertainment spots foreign workers
 - Autonomous Participation: married immigrants, immigrated children, foreign students, densely populated areas- dwelling foreigners
- Course
 - Common Subjects: Basic Laws and Systems, Life Information, System in relation to Immigration requiring two hours
 - Special Subjects: ethnic Korean visiting Republic of Korea for the purpose of getting jobs (procedure of acquiring nationality), married immigrants (mutual understanding between family members), hotels or entertainment spots foreign workers (human rights protection) requiring an hour
- Benefit of Earning Credits : married immigrants are given a 2-year stay period.

Method of Registration

Select the menu at Social Integration Information Network (www.socinet.go.kr) before registering.

Nationality applicants should make a reservation through the internet before visiting~

From Jul. 15, 2020, the reservation system of visit for nationality registration starts a test operation.

Ministry of Justice announced that nationality applicants as of Jul. 15, 2020 should access HiKorea (www.hikorea.go.kr) to make a reservation on the date and place of visit, and that the corresponding organization users can file civil petitions, immediately.

A visit reservation can be available from two months before visit, to the day before visit. For a visit, a reservation ticket issued from HiKorea should be submitted to a window for civil petitions.

Work in relation to the Reservation of Visit

- **Permission:** permission of nationalization and the recovery of nationality
- **Report:** loss of nationality, option of nationality, retention of nationality, nationality acquisition by stamp attached, nationality acquisition, reacquisition of nationality
- **Issued Confirmation :** confirmation of renunciation of foreign nationality, written oath of fulfilling foreign nationality

Dormant Insurance Claims Program?

The program to fund responsibility for dormant claims completing the limitation period- responsibility related to statutory insurance (admission cost insurance, departure guarantee insurance) for foreign workers to transfer from the speciality insurance company to organizations under the wing of HRDK (Human Resources Development Service of Korea), and EPS Center which receive application forms for the claims.

※ Dormant Insurance Claims : amounts kept by the corporation- even if its limitation period has run out after three years as of the date when there began to happen the reason of payment for insurance

- Applicant : person in party privileged to hold dormant insurance claims
- Method of Registration : registering through a visit or fax
- Documents to be Submitted:
 - ① application form of payment for dormant insurance claims
 - ② a copy of ID
 - ③ a copy of bank book of a person in party to hold dormant claims, or a copy of bank statement
 - ④ confirmation of scheduled departure

We strongly advise you to refrain from going out and stay home, if possible, in order to prevent COVID-19.



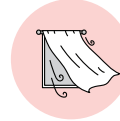
It is advised that you should stay home and take a rest when you have heat or symptoms (coughing, throat pain) of respiratory system.

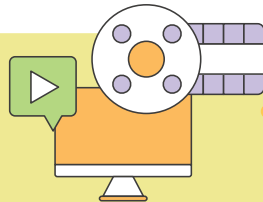

Wise Volunteer Works to Overcome COVID-19!

Multi-Cultural Hanul Volunteers produced 2,000 necklaces for preventing the loss of masks, from the last August to September. It is routine for people to wear their masks, in the situation regarding COVID-19. But, when eating meals, they cannot but take off their masks, which often incurs the incident of losing masks or keeping them dirty. In this regard, such necklaces enable people to prevent the loss of masks and health maintenance, because they are linked to the ties of masks. Also, Hanul Volunteers packed masks and donated a total of 2,000 sets of 'Safe Mask Kits (2 masks + 1 necklace for preventing the loss of masks)' to Yeongdeungpo sport Association for the disabled, centers for the children, 12 of multi-cultural Nursey.

Merits of Using Political Contributions Center

- Easy to check the accounts of Supports Association and deliver personal information
- Easy to inquire the details of sponsors and issue receipts
- Easy to use services for settlement of the end of the year

Political Contribution Deducted for Year-end Tax adjustment for the Settlement of the End of the Year

- Tax deduction of entire costs to 100,000 won at maximum annually
- Tax deduction to 15% for amounts of more than 100,000 won (to 25% for amounts of more than 300,000 won)

Yeongdeungpo-gu Information about Separating and Removing Garbage, Properly

- Use the bags for food garbage and remove them in RFID devices, please.
- In case when moving out of the residence, use transparent vinyls for recycling goods and remove. For non-combustible materials, use specific standard plastic bag and remove, please.
- For cans, PET, glass bottles, separate and remove as recycling goods.
- For cotton bedclothes, pillows, electric blankets, hot water mats and more, report as large waste matters to community center, and then remove.

Throwing out garbage without a permit incurs a fine of **less than 1 million won** at maximum, under Article 8 of Wastes Control Act and Article 68 of the same act.

Emergency Reduction Measures against PM (Particulate Matters)?

Measures to reduce air pollutants discharging out of automobiles, factories, and construction sites, for the purpose of reducing the sustained PM (Particulate Matters) of high levels around Seoul metropolitan areas, within a short term

When there happens much PM (Particulate Matters), it is advised to do as follows

- Refraining from going out, if possible, and wearing masks for health (certified by KFDA)
- When going out, avoiding where there is severe air pollution, and reducing activities
- Managing air quality by keeping indoors clean with mops
- Stopping running obsolete cars and appointed by Seoul emission vehicles
- Using public transportation means, instead of automobiles
- Refraining from emergency starts, stops and idling.
- For vehicles that discharge exhaust fume, reporting at '120.'
- Actively engaging in Odd-Even License Plate Policy
- After going out, washing off the bodies, and consuming water and fruits.

Nutrition Plus Program

- **Period**
 - Period of Recruitment : throughout the year
 - Period of Benefit : six months at minimum~ a year at maximum
- **Subject**
 - Those having less than 80% of median earning, out of pregnant, childbearing and lactating women having babies and infants under 6 years (66 months) in the areas
- **Contents**
 - Providing nutrition education for a better health, to pregnant, lactating women, babies and infants who have a problem with nutrition condition
 - Providing supplementary food (eggs, milk, potatoes, carrots, laver, and so on), for a certain period
 - Counseling on nutrition in order to address a problem with malnutrition
